

A Good Cleaner's List of Tasks

Before your cleaner starts:

- Name the cleaning products with each room written on the bottles with permanent marker
- Put all products, rags & other equipment into a bucket to be easily moved to each room
- Put out clean linen (sheet sets, pillow cases, towels & table cloths)
- Provide soap and toilet rolls for refill
- Printer paper for refill
- Provide tubs or boxes for loose items to be piled into by cleaner & sorted out by family later
- Provide designated bags for laundry
- Wash Dogs & Cats same day as cleaner comes. Clean house, clean animals, smells good!
- Provide pet food for refill
- MAKE A STATEMENT!

For example, Our Family's Cleaning Standard Statement:

"This is a chemical free home. Please use only the biodegradable cleaning products provided. We love our children and DON'T want poisons added to their palette nor their future."

OR

"Please use only the cleaning products provided for the room specified."

"All kitchen surfaces to be able to be eaten from."

OR

"Your own inserted here."

Jobs to do on the way home:

- Ironing, washing and drycleaning to elaundry
- Gas bottle refilled
- Mower fuel refilled
- Collect Fire wood
- Pets dropped to Groomer
- Knives to sharpener
- Shoes to repair man
- Clothes repairs like hems taken up to elaundry

Other special instructions to keep in mind:

- Laminate the cleaner's checklist & write on your weekly Special Requests with white board marker
- Hang personalised laminated list on wall next to mop handle/eye level in closet!
- Work the room: Clean from the door clockwise around the room so that when you're done you're back at the door.
- Manage your own clean: Close the door of each room after you've cleaned, then go back to check that each one is perfect and leave door open.
- Book other services like pool man, car washing, dog wash, mower man etc whilst the cleaner is there to let them in & pay them...only need to give out ONE KEY!!!
