- 2. Detergent Solution4. Solvent (only on dry carpet)
- 5. Chill with aerosol freezing or
- ice cubes in plastic bag
 - 6. Vinegar Solution
 - 7. Warm Water
- 8. Clear nail polish remover (no lanolin)
- 9. Alcohol (eg. Isocol, surgical alcohol)
 - 10. Rust remover
 - 11. Vacuum
 - 12. Mineral Turpentine
 - 13. Ammonia Solution
- 14. Clear household disinfectant
- 15. Baking Soda, scoop up and vacuum
